Hate Speech Vs Free Speech

Freedom of expression is enshrined in international law. Some individuals, however, misunderstand the right to share their opinions as a license to target others with the most horrendous prejudice. So how do we balance people's prerogative to have their voice heard against everyone's right to live in a respectful, inclusive society?



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This conflict frequently unfolds in the digital world. Online posters can be falsely accused of hate speech, while actual hate is often defended as merely being 'free speech'. To help children and young people learn to identify the boundaries and recognise genuine hate speech when they see it, the #WakeUpWednesday guide at the end of the bulletin, provides some helpful definitions and guidelines.

New School Menu and Price Increase

From Monday 8th April we have a new school menu which can be viewed <u>here.</u> Once again, this is a 3-week rotating menu which will run until November 2024. For a more comprehensive menu, including full allergen information on the dishes provided visit <u>schoolmeals.bradford.gov.uk</u>.

We have also been notified by FM Catering that there will be a small increase in the price of a school meal, from $\pounds 2.25$ to $\pounds 2.35$. This will take effect from Monday 8th April.

If your child is in Year 3 or above and you think you may be eligible for Free School Meals, please complete the short form on the <u>Bradford Council website</u>. Children who receive free school meals are also eligible for other benefits including school uniform allowance, free school milk, one free after school club and/or breakfast club sessions.

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive Universal Free School Meals, however, you may still apply via the form above. If you are successful, you will receive the benefits outlined above, as well as free school meals when your child enters Year 3.

All children will be given the opportunity to see the lambs, however, please inform your child's teacher or the school office if would prefer your child not to get close to the lambs, due to allergies or otherwise. 
